Title: Letter about quarentine

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Keywords: to be used after in search function on the website **#writing skills,# expression# informal letter#** formal **letter**

Duration:30minutes.

Description:

With these activities students will learn to differentiate the different types of letters and what differentiates a formal letter from an informal letter.

For the first activity the class will be divided into pairs of students, each one must write an informal letter to his/her partner where he/she tells how the quarantine has been, how he/she has felt, what he/she has done, what he/she has learned etc...

For the second activity, each student has to imagine that he/she is the headmaster of the school and write a formal letter to the parents of the students indicating the measures that will be taken to fight the Covid 19 in the school.

Objectives:

Activity(ies) (Stages):

In this activity you will perform two individual tasks:

First, write an informal letter to a classmate telling him or her about your experience during the quarantine as a result of Covid 19.

For the second task you will have to imagine that you are the Director of the school and you have to write a letter to the parents to explain the measures that the school is going to take against the Covid.

Tips for trainers

With the help of educational guidelines directed by the teacher, the proposes is students practice what they have learned by writing two letters: an informal one addressed to a friend, and a formal one.

The activity can be adapted for students to use text editing tools and will be handled in virtual environments such as Google Docs
